If You Are A Student of WW II You Will Find Yourself Referring To This Often By George O'Leary The text for this Atlas Of World War II, first published by Bison Books Ltd., of London in 1985, and compiled by Richard Natkiel, comes from Robin L. Sommer, a prolific writer whose other wildly divergent efforts include *The Little Book Of Cats: Poems And Prose*, *On Fifth Avenue: Highlights Of Architectural And Cultural History*, and *Pablo Picasso*, while the 4-page Introduction is contributed by S. L. Mayer, whose works include *Signal- Hitler's Wartime Picture Magazine*, *The Biography Of General Of The Army Douglas MacArthur*, and *Weapons Of The Gulf War*. In assembling this 192-page 8 3/4 x 11 compendium of the event of WW II, Richard Natkiel (whose other such efforts include *Atlas Of Battles: Strategy And Tactics Civil War To Present* - first published in 1984, *Atlas Of 20th Century Warfare* and *Soviet Objectives In The Middle East Report Of A Study Group Of The Institute For The Study Of Conflict*, January 1974) divides his material under these eleven headings: *Blitzkrieg* (pages 10 to 31); *The War In Northern Waters* (page 32 to 41); *The Desert War And The Mediterranean* (pages 42 to 63); *Soviet Ambitions Betrayed* (pages 64 to 77); *The Course Of Global Conflicts* (pages 78 to 95); *The Japanese Juggernaut* (pages 96 to 107); *The Italian Campaigns* (pages 108 to 119); *Ebb Tide In The Pacific* (pages 120 to 137); *Retaking Burma: The Forgotten War* (pages 138 to 147); *Russia Finds Its Strength* (pages 148 to 165); *Fortress Europe Overthrown* (page 166 to 189). These are followed by a 3-page

alphabetical index. Within each section are fully-detailed battle maps, some in color, including Orders of Battle, all liberally sprinkled with action photographs and those of the main personalities involved.
