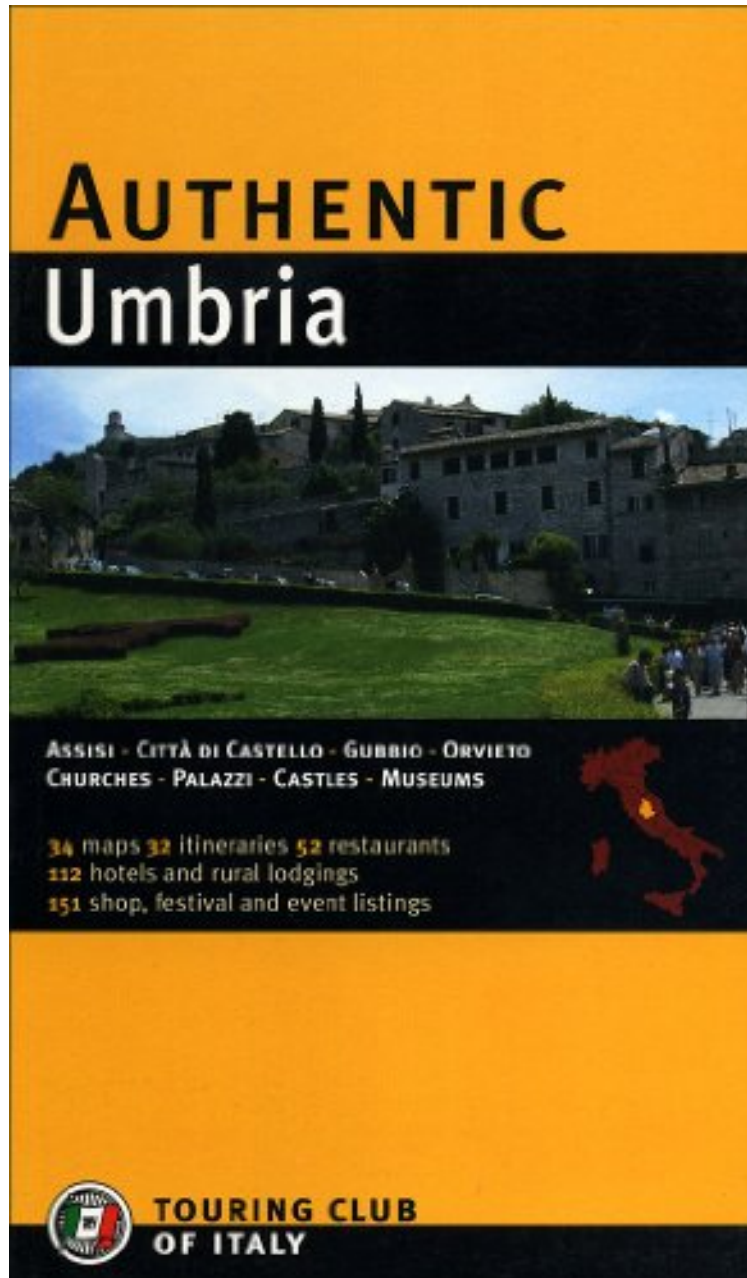

This guide has plenty of information but one thing that is very frustrating is that it doesn't tell you where certain things mentioned in the text are located. The larger scale maps of Umbria are rather weak . An example of missing information pertains to the section "medieval umbria." A number of places are mentioned in that section but there is no information as to their location.

Umbria stands out as one of Italys most enchanting and desirable destinations, a region resonant with history. This guidebook, written by insiders who know the region intimately, hits all the high points for visitors: the magnificent architecture of the capital, Perugia; splendid Gubbio, rich with medieval and renaissance landmarks; and Terni, a modern industrial city that features some of the countrys most beautiful churches. The book also includes natural wonders, including the Waterfall of Marmore, and the significant Christian destination Assisi, birthplace of Saint Francis.
