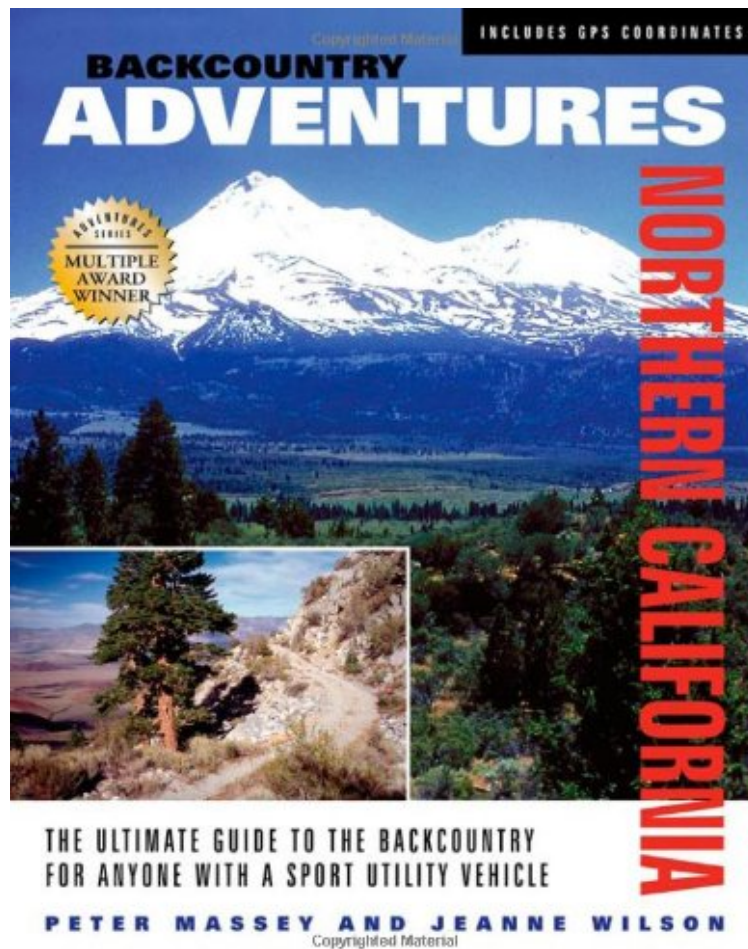

Interesting book, but GPS coordinates are way off. Customer I like the layout of this book and the history etc., BUT the actual GPS coordinates don't point to the trails. Plugging coordinates into Google Maps, or my Garmin GPS or Google Earth or Magellan driod app, and the tracks are WAY OFF (several miles). Seems like this would be a huge problem for people getting lost. Am I missing something here?
