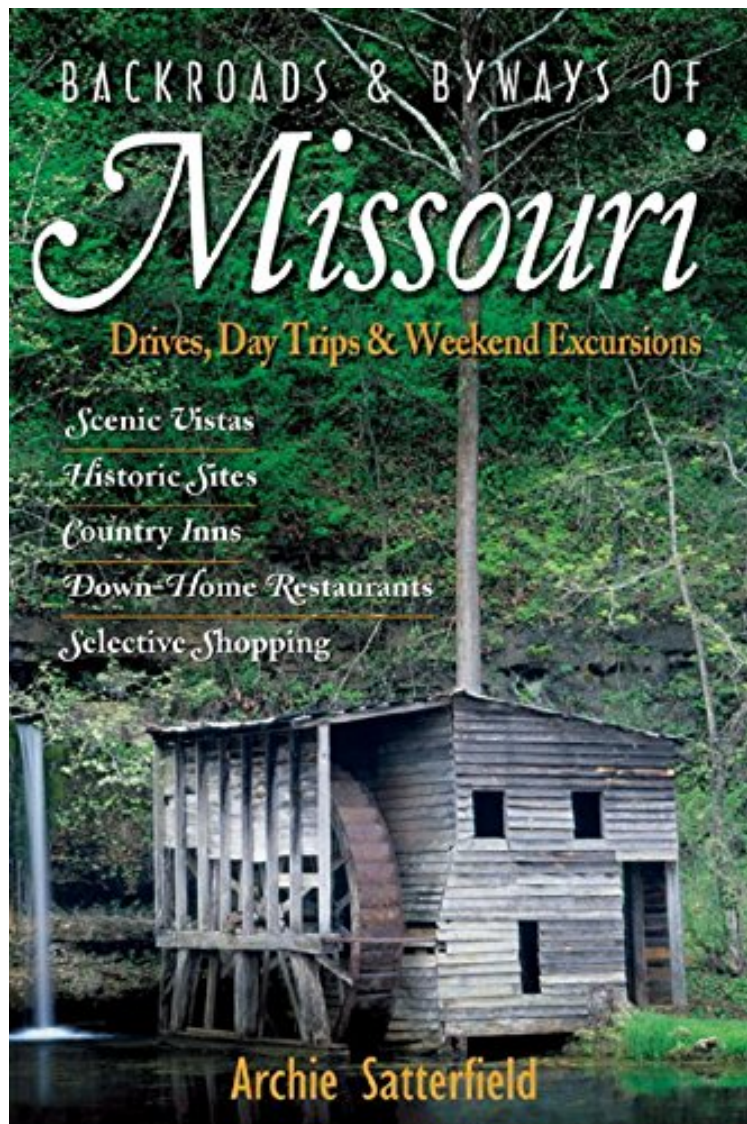


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Backroads Byways of Missouri: Drives, Day Trips Weekend Excursions (Backroads Byways)
