I have NEVER read a novel with so many typographical errors. At first I thought that it might be the author doing something different but then I compared it to other editions and hence the proof that this book was very poorly proofread. There are at least 20 typos and not only are they obvious but they sometimes leave you wondering what you are missing. Here are some examples: CQue bonita eres,...(p88) / -ierto que,..(p206) / CMe he olvidado de mis...(p102) / -omprendiendo que,..(p245) / -on una misma suspicacia...(p255).
