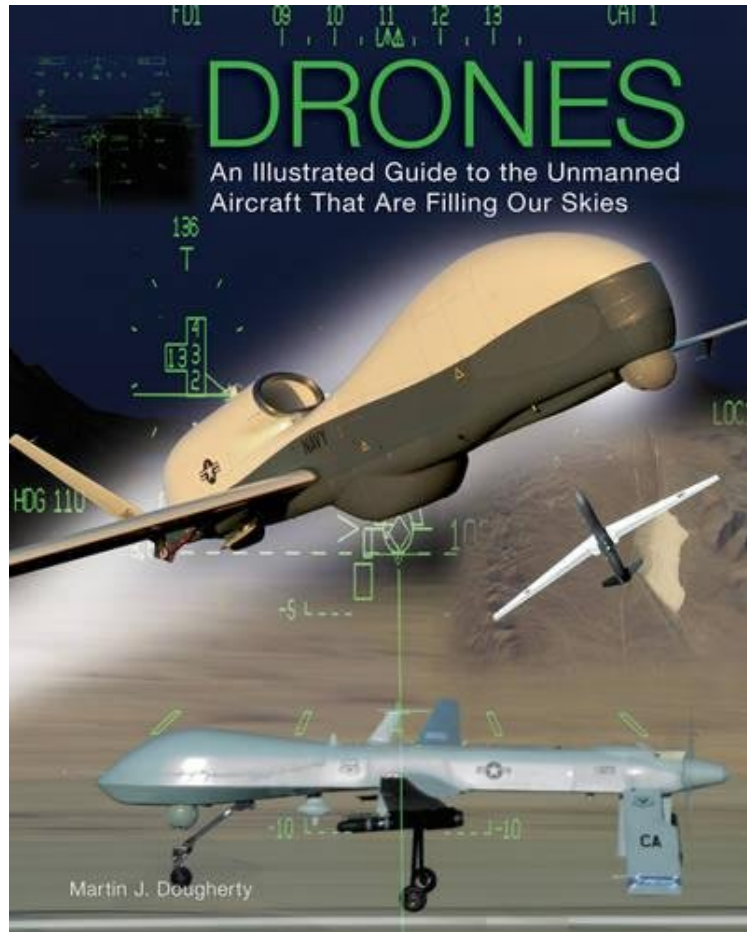

I like how the author provides diagrams of how our country's most formidable UAVs operate, and he even provides a bar graph showing how many people have been killed by US drone strikes in Yemen and Pakistan because drone strikes have been criticized as extrajudicial and represent a case study in the logic of just war (that is, you use military action wisely to avoid killing innocent civilians).
