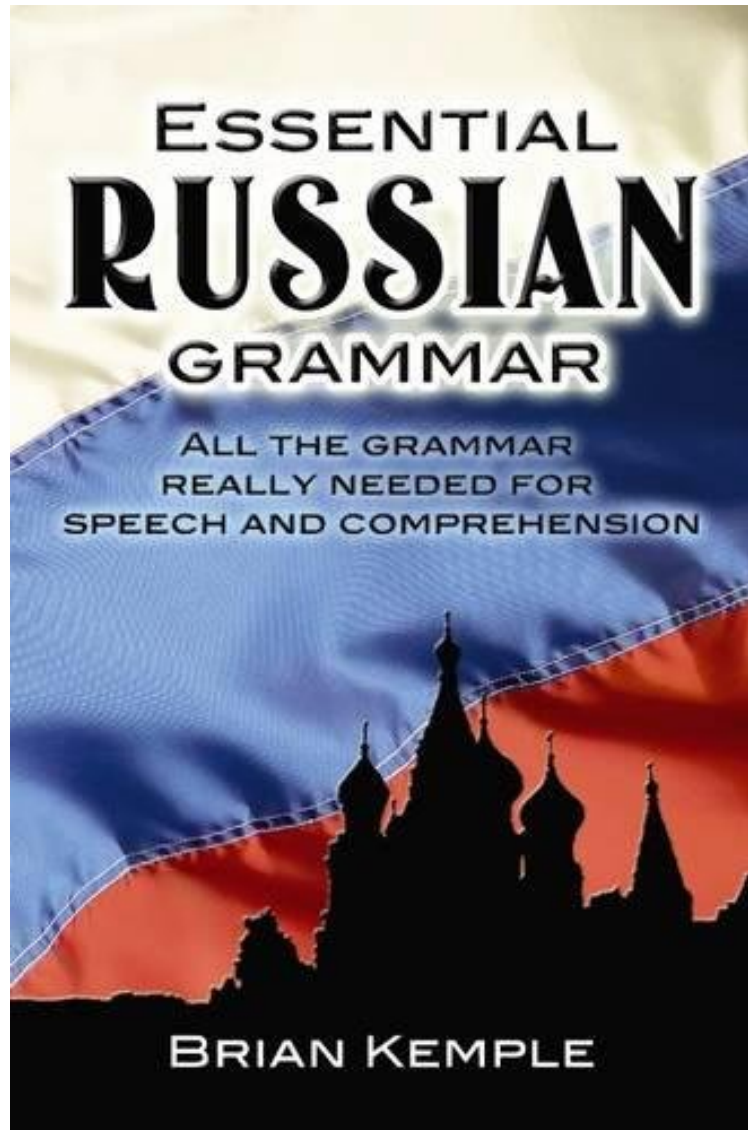

feeding it you get the opposite feeling. It seems that nothing is forgotten. Versatile and carefully formulated explanations are always provided with examples and translations. Stress is always indicated. Much trouble is seen to overcome the limitations of the screen. A special treatment is offered for complicated tables. You may click and get the table as such without surrounding text in front of you and the return back where you were. (Which means it's easier to carry around, and easier to use as a quick reference, but also means that it's not as comprehensive of course, and therefore leaves out lots of examples of [for example] where the Genitive Case should be used.
