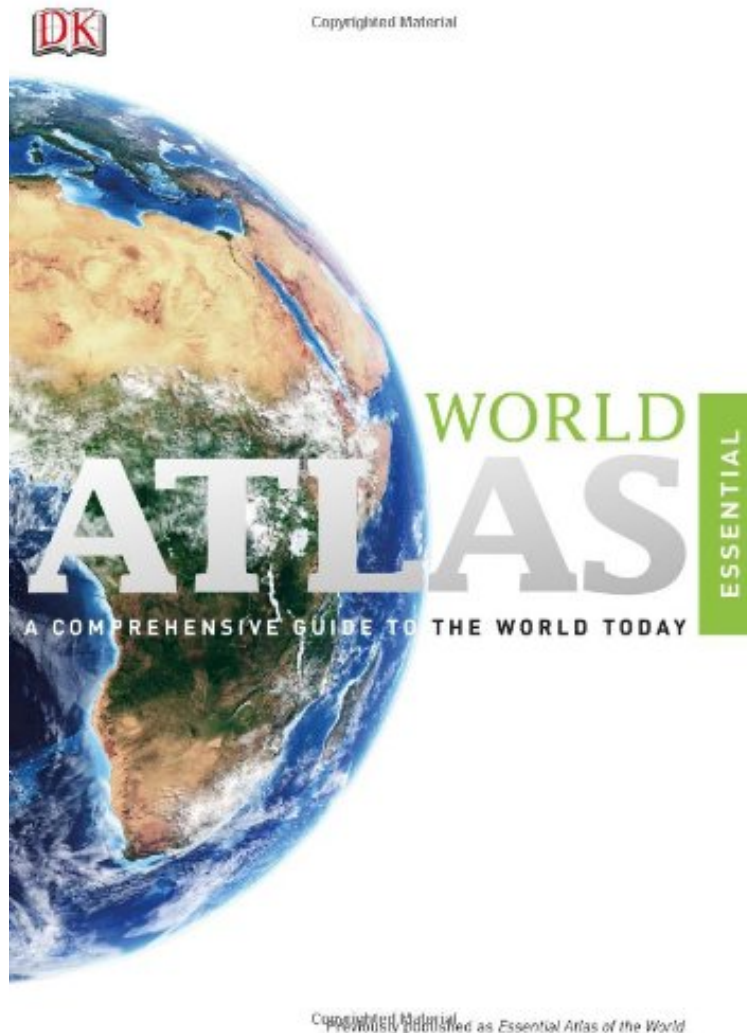

Someone didn't think through how to organize the flags. By Carroll I bought this for \$10.39. As other customers have said, there is a lack of detail. One of the stupidest things about this book is how the flag pages are organized. Rather than sequencing the flags by country name, the flags are sequenced based on how the countries show up in the book (i.e.: Canada on pages 36-39, United States on pages 40-49, Mexico on pages 50-51, Belize on pages 52-53, etc.). I don't understand how that will help me look up the flag I want to look at. It would've been better if the flags were sequenced based on the countries name (i.e.: Belize on pages 52-53, Canada on pages 36-39, Mexico on pages 50-51, United States on pages 40-49, etc.). If I had known about the lack of details and the oddly organized flag pages, would I buy this book? Absolutely not. Is it a totally awful book? Also absolutely not.
