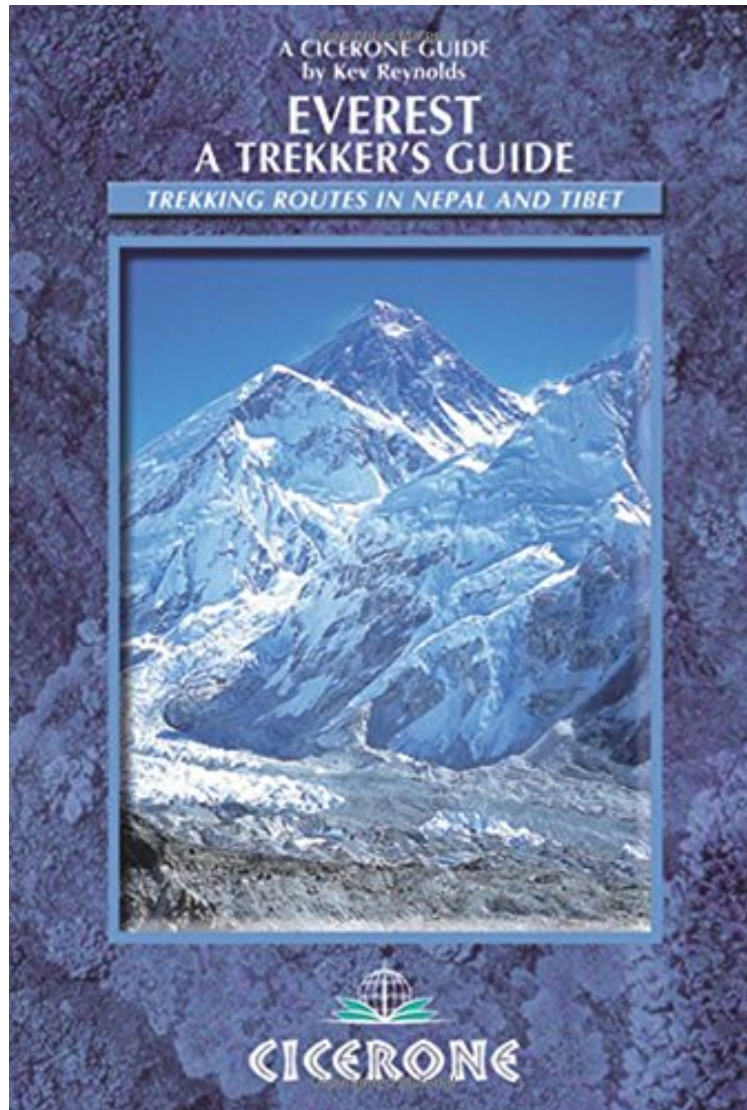

Includes the route in Tibet from Tingri to the North side Base Camp and Rongbuk monastery/glacier.
