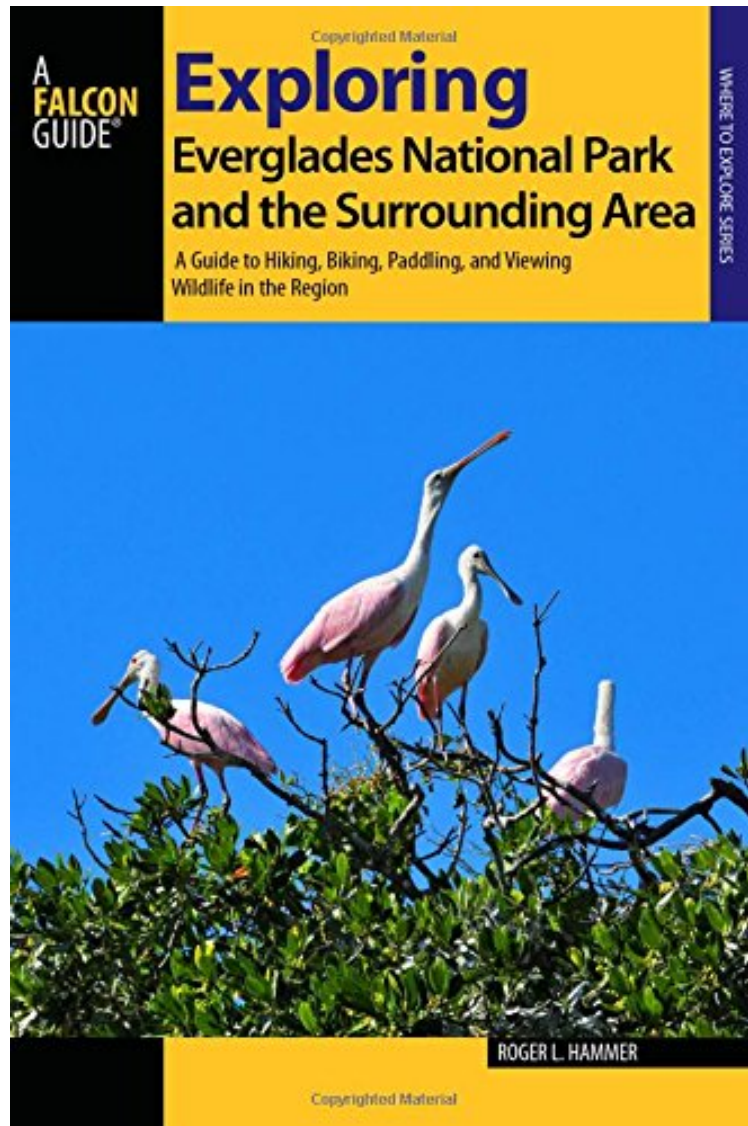

There are many small, detailed maps, but it was hard for me to see the big picture until we got there. Get a park service map as soon as you can. There are many, many pictures and lots of helpful info about the area. Keep in mind this is a very large national park and there are 4 visitor centers with different activities available at each of them. If you have limited time to experience this large park, I would recommend the Shark Valley loop...walk it, bike it, or take the tram. Also the Anhinga Trail near the Ernest Coe Visitor center. Both could be done easily in one day.
