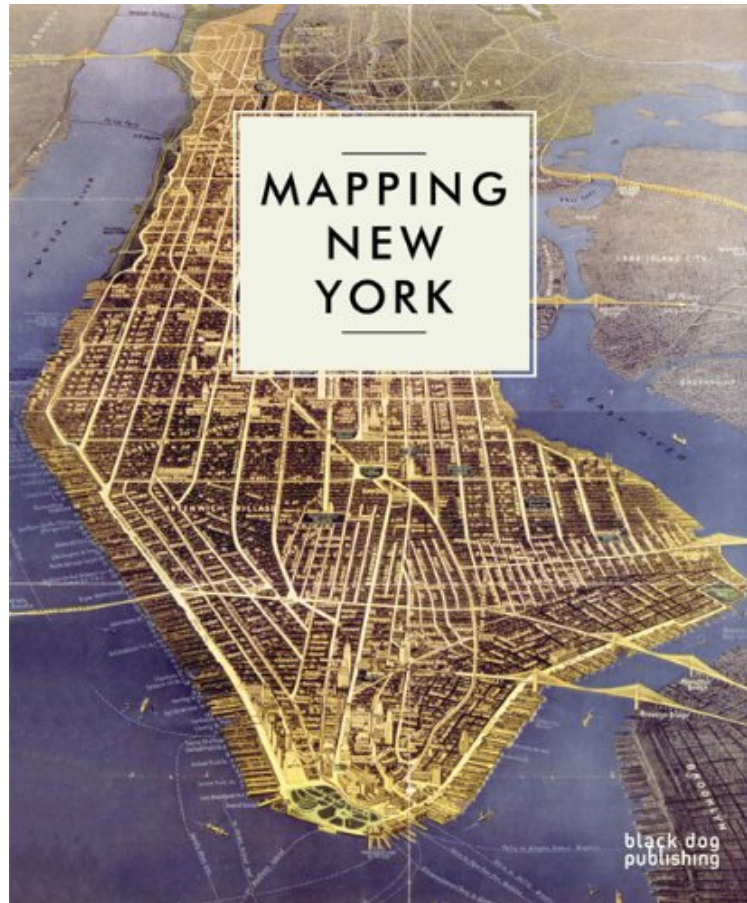

The only reason I do not give it 5 stars is that some maps are printed at a size which prevents adequate detail from being seen, even with a magnifier.
