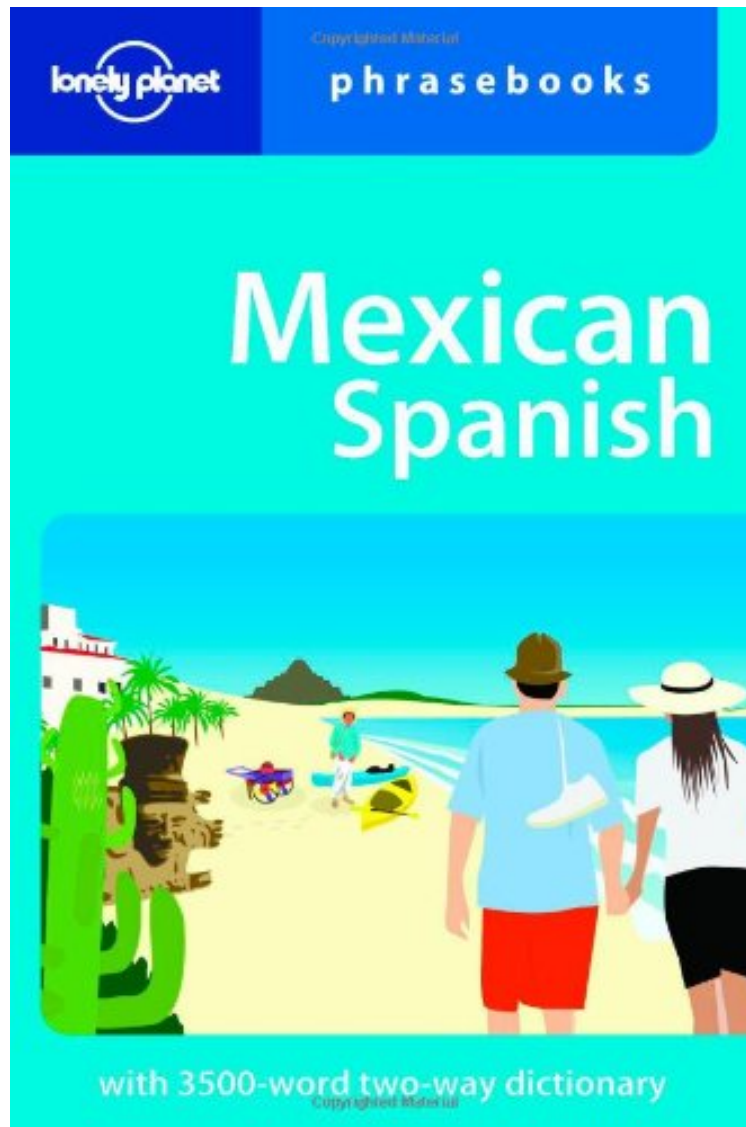

The sections were well organized and easy to find. I also loved that it had a very long and thorough food dictionary. The only thing that I wish this book had was a more extensive dictionary so when you wanted to form your own sentences, you can look up specific verbs.
