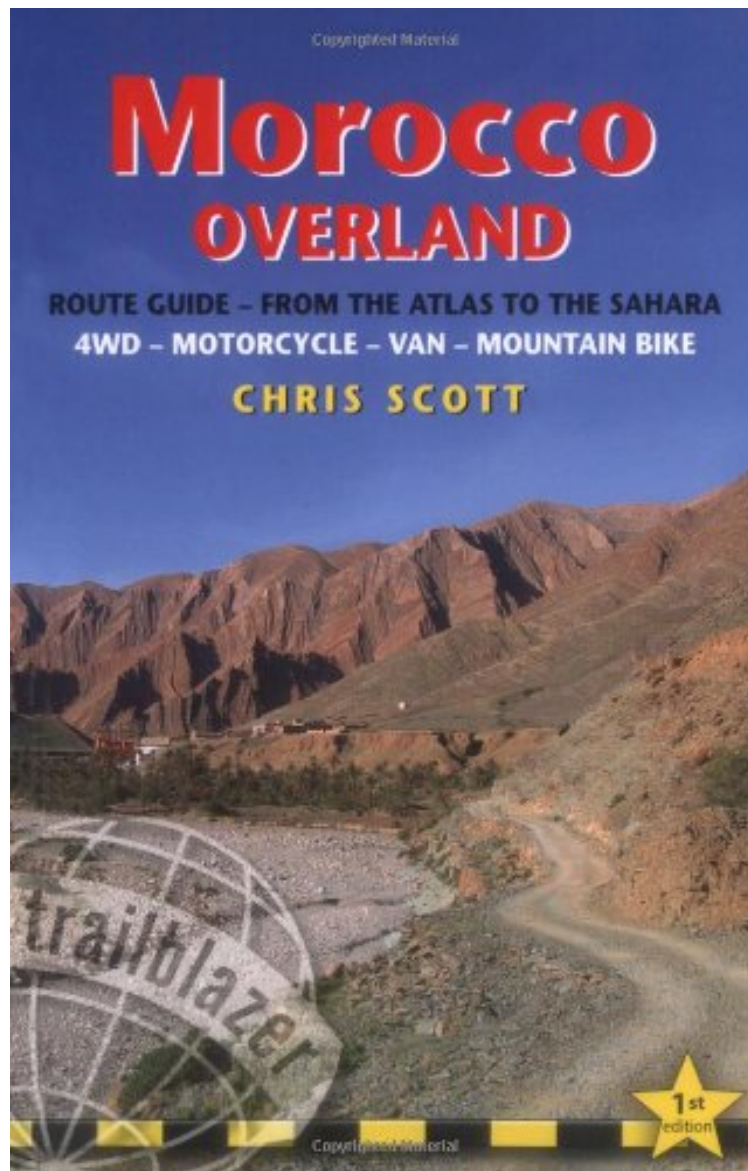

I am planning a motorcycle trip to Morocco in the spring of 2010 and recently received this book. From what I've seen, it is an excellent resource for those looking for interesting routes. The suitability of each route for various types of transport (4WD, big bikes, mountain bikes) is addressed, which is very helpful. You will need another guide book to address things to see and places to stay, this book is pretty much about the roads in between, although it does cover some sights along the way. I will update this review once I'm back to let you know if this evaluation stands after using the book on the ground.

For the independently-mobile traveller the mountains and deserts of southern Morocco are a year-round destination offering a thrilling variety of experiences. Covering over 9000km from the High Atlas to the Mauritanian border, Morocco Overland features detailed GPS off-road routes for 4WDs, motorcycles and mountain bikes as well as scenic byways suitable for any vehicle. The book also includes guidance on choosing and preparing vehicles, the best places and times to go, getting to Morocco as well as local fly-drive options and off-road driving and riding techniques.
