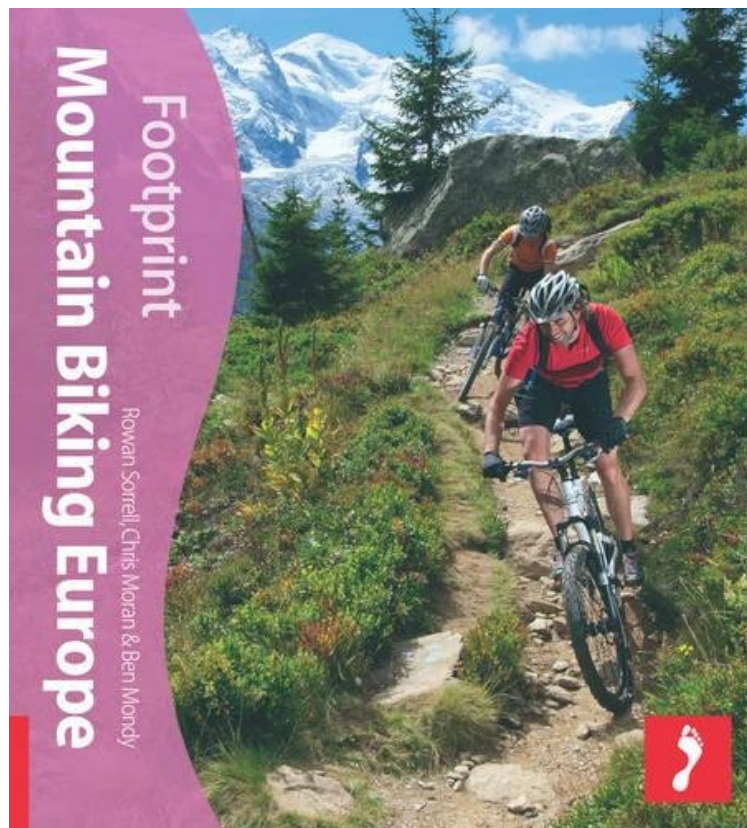

Unlike the U.S., Europe does not have the trail resources readily accessible on the internet. It can be found but knowing where to start from is the key. This book has been my go-to place on where to start. It would inform me if there were trail maps available, if it was a bike park, refer me to certain bike stores, or if I needed to hire a guide. The pictures were amazing. At the beginning of each region, there was recommendation from a MTB pro on where they would ride in that area. And each location would inform you of the difficulty according to MTB discipline. What was also great is that the difficulty ratings are standard across the book. Where-else if you went to certain locations the ratings are all

relative according to location especially when you're not from the area. For example, a location might call something freeride when it's just a regular singletrack in the U.S. This is a must have to anyone planning on riding and traveling in Europe.
