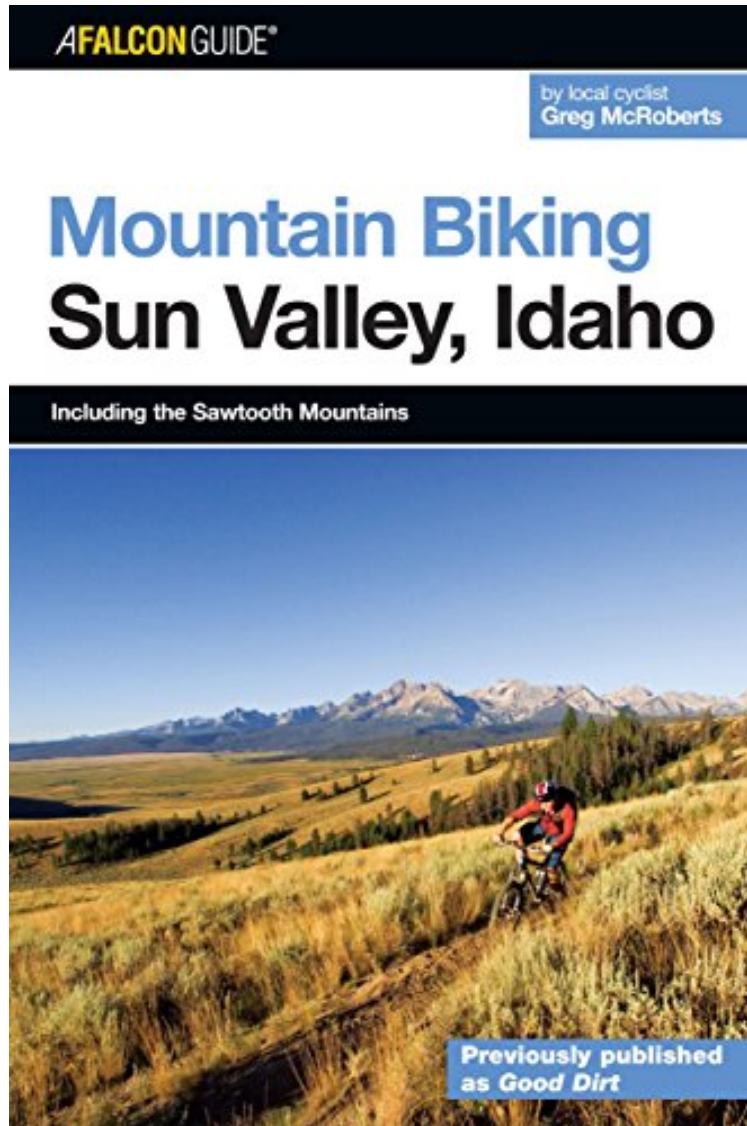

His descriptions of elevation gain and difficulty I found pretty good. The Adams Gulch loop, for example, was rated "Abusive" and while not overly difficult with 2200' of climbing, it did have several sections of hike-a-bike on the ascent that I assume drove the rating. Maps were excellent and I didn't have any issues with route finding. He also incorporated some humor - after all this is all about mountain biking and having fun. Highly recommended for anyone planning to ride in Sun Valley.
